My name is AJ Long and I am the sponsorship coordinator for the Anniston Runners Club in 2024. Thank you for your continued support of our organization. We had a very successful year in 2023 and want to continue our growth into 2024 by supporting our community and promoting the benefits of running.

Anniston Runners Club hosted the RRCA National 5K Championship in Anniston in 2023. We did not make a profit, but rather an investment. We donated over \$6,400 to local organizations through Woodstock (over \$2,000 more than 2022), including The Arc of Calhoun & Cleburne Counties and local schools. In addition to Woodstock donations, the Anniston Runners Club contributed a total of \$5,900 to other organizations including local non-profits, such as the YMCA and the RMC Colon Cancer Research. We also make donations to local charities and present two local high school scholarships in the spring. We would like to continue this momentum in 2024.

To make this happen, the Board recently approved a new sponsorship package, including updated perks of being an Anniston Runners Club sponsor, a new sponsorship level, and updated information on the club as a whole. **Club History:** The Anniston Runners Club was formed in 1980 when a group of Anniston businessmen, who ran together each Sunday afternoon for fitness, decided to form a running club. After a Sunday run, they met at one of their homes and drew up the bylaws. One of their first member meetings was at Golden Springs Community Center with Dr. Charles Veale speaking on health and fitness. The club began to grow, and within three years, the club had 180 members that consisted of doctors, lawyers, bankers, insurance agents, Mayor Norwood Hodges, teachers, and others. The name Anniston Runners Club (ARC) was chosen.

At the time the ARC was formed, the biggest local foot race held in Anniston in conjunction with the Alabama Shakespeare Festival was the Midsummer Morn 5K, which was sponsored by the Anniston Star, but ARC helped coordinate it, as well. When the Shakespeare Festival moved to Montgomery in 1986, ARC and the Star agreed ARC could adopt the race. Since the race was held on Woodstock Avenue, it was renamed the Woodstock 5K.

The Woodstock 5K has been an historic course since 2013, when the Calhoun County Historic Preservation Committee and the City of Anniston designated it as such. The city funded the production and erection of two beautiful historic markers for the start and finish of our signature race. While our club is named "Anniston" Runners Club, it is by no means exclusively an Anniston club...or even just a Calhoun County entity.

**Mission Statement:** The Anniston Runners Club (ARC) is committed to promoting, encouraging, and fostering the love of running. We strive to promote the healthy benefits of running and mentor new runners.

**Non-Profit Status:** Anniston Runners Club is granted 501(c)(3) status through our membership in the Road Runners Club of America. Donations, contributions, and sponsorship of our club are tax deductible.

**Events:** Anniston Runners Club (ARC) hosts six running events and supports The Fab Four Challenge Series.

**Meetings:** ARC holds monthly officer meetings to organize upcoming events and member meetings and social

events. ARC hosts an Annual Banquet to celebrate a successful year, to honor winners of the Challenge Series, Mile-a-Day Club (MAD), and the 1200 Mile Club and other mileage awards, to recognize other

accomplishments, and to announce the election of officers for the year.

**Divisions:** 

To serve the needs of our membership, the club has a variety of divisions including (all of which are free):

**Youth Running** – We offer an exciting program geared to elementary-age children designed to motivate them to enjoy the physical benefits of running and walking.

**Trail Running Division** – We hold a variety of trail-training options, and support and volunteer for local trail events, such as the Pinhoti 100 and Chief Ladiga 100.

**Triathlon Division** – Members of ARC participate in races that involve running, biking, and swimming. ARC is also a supporter and sponsor of the Treadhoofalon, a triathlon with horseback riding, biking, and trail running.

**Women's Running Division** – Women's running focuses on protection, training, and injury/nutrition education, through events like workshops.

**Rookie Runners/Walkers** - This outreach is to local prospective runners who have never run, have not run in a long time, or are recovering from injury. It also supports individuals who walk for a lifestyle. Whatever level someone is, we partner ARC members with them to encourage and support them.

**Kidstock 1K:** Since 1981, the Woodstock 5K has been ARC's signature race. The

course starts at Anniston High School and winds its way through the historic Woodstock neighborhood. It has been a Championship Race of

the Road Runners Club of America 15 times.

The Kidstock 1K is held in conjunction with ARC's Woodstock 5K, the first Saturday in August. It is geared towards the first-time younger runner.

October Halloween Scavenger Hunt: The week before Halloween, we hold a free event, open to the public: our

scavenger hunt in Fort McClellan where runners solve clues and run from

location to location.

**November Plucked Turkey 10K:** On Thanksgiving morning, runners participate in a low-key 10K race. Over 150

runners participate each year. Awards of smoked turkeys and pies are presented. Partnered with the YMCA of Calhoun County, proceeds go to Regional Medical

Center and the YMCA.

**Challenge Series Events:** ARC supports a Challenge Series, the Fab Four. The series consists of four ARC

premier races. After the season is completed, ARC honors the overall top 3 winning male and female competitors at the ARC banquet. Everyone who

completes the series receives a t-shirt.
