Old Business	Building for NEABA/ARC	Del Marsh has agreed to lease the old Hall Building Materials Building to NEABA and ARC, if ARC decides to be a part of the endeavor. The lease would be for \$1 per year for 10 years. The clubs would be responsible for utilities and insurance. The building is 6500 square feet and is basically a shell at the moment. The city will help with obtaining permits needed to start construction. Brooke has agreed to head up everything and has ideas for some fundraisers for reconstruction. The building will serve as club headquarters, as well as storage for the club, meeting space, etc. A decision on this was not made at the meeting and has been tabled for the time being.
