The Kidstock 1 Mile Run/Walk will start at 8:30 a.m. All participants will receive finisher medals. Parents are welcomed to run with younger children. **There is no race-day registration.**

Kidstock Awards: New - DTag Timing!

Only 14-year olds and younger are eligible for Kidstock awards. The following overall trophies will be awarded:1st, 2nd, 3rd Place Overall Male/Female

Kidstock trophies will be given to the top three finishers, male and female, in each age category: 5-under; 6-8; 9-11; 12-14.

Kid's Corral: Registration required. No fee.

Don't let your kids keep you from running the 5K! The Kid's Corral is available - sign in your child to our childcare volunteers at 7:15 a.m. and pick them up when you finish the 5K race! Then let them run the Kidstock 1 Mile Run/Walk! The Kid's Corral activities will be located right by the finish. You must check the box on the entry form to let us know you need space. The number is limited to 30 kids.


